7:35pm 47 Beach Avenue discussion of Certificate of Compliance issues

Rocky Ostroff attended the meeting to discuss what would be needed to have a Certificate of Compliance issued for his project. Mr. Ostroff had an Order of Conditions for installing pavers in his driveway and has installed them in areas not indicated on approved plans. Mr. Ostroff was instructed to submit a plan for the Commission to review that accurately shows the areas where pavers were installed. Mr. Ostroff stated that he would submit a plan and also photographs of the area.

**11 Dellawanda discussion** of Certificate of Compliance issues – Ms. Herbst informed the Commission that she has had conversations with the Applicant as well as the new homeowner regarding work completed under the Order of Conditions. It is apparent that the existing vegetated area that was to remain untouched has been altered. The Commission will conduct a site visit to view the property for current conditions and possible mitigation items.
