Owner/Applicant: Daniel & Christine McCormack Documents: Driveway Plan – dated 9/11/2013

Mr. McCormack presented the project that is to include removing and replacing the existing paved driveway. The width will be 8' wide at the street and expand to 9 1/2 feet at the deck. Mr. McCormack made a notation on the plan indicating that the driveway will be terminated at the edge of the deck.

A Special Condition was added as follows:

- The paving cannot extend past the rear edge of the deck (as indicated on the plan of record).
