Tickets for violations have been issued to the owners of 64 Holbrook Ave. and 39 Bay Street with no response to date.

A. Herbst informed the Commission that she is working with Aquarion on a contingency plan with indicating proper protocol should a leak ever occur in the pipes that are under the dunes.

Herbst also informed the Commission CZM has released their draft updated Ocean Management Plan to include investigation of sand nourishment. They propose 3 pilot programs in the next 5 years.
