The Aquarium building is for sale for 1.4 million. Commercial Rec C District.

Evergreen Medical Marijuana met with the Selectmen and Planning Board for an informational meeting on 9/14/17.

An application for technical assistance has been submitted to MAPC to help in the development of a skate park on Nantasket Avenue near the Middle School.

The Town received a Complete Streets grant to reconstruct the section of Nantasket Avenue from H to Q streets with ADA compliant sidewalks and bike lanes.

The grant application for the Waveland gas station will be filed by 11/16/17. Rotary Club is working on signage pertaining to Hull being a Coast Guard City.

Wellspring is looking to expand their food co-op operation to include fresh produce. In addition, they have logged over 80 housing issues with their patrons over the last 6 months.

The lifesaving museum is interested in placing historic pictures in the windows of vacant buildings and plaques at the boat launch.

The committee is going to look to set up a meeting with area business owners to get a feel for the business climate, hear about their challenges and successes, and begin to develop a plan for ways the town can help the business community be more successful.
