Public Input

Mark Forest talked briefly about offshore wind and how the wind industry is moving towards larger turbines. Pat Cannon asked Mark Forest about using larger turbines and how this would affect the permitting process. Would we have to start from square one? Mark was not sure. This will be addressed at a later date. Mark said there is a slow down in the wind industry because of the price of natural gas being so affordable. Mark said this is not a bad thing and it will give the wind industry time to regroup and develop more cutting edge equipment. Mark touched on the Jones Act and said this problem has not been addressed.

Manager's Report

Budget 2012 – Dick said 2011 is not completely closed out yet. Several questions were asked about 2012 and 2011 Budgets and seemed to be answered by management so as to satisfy all members.

Municipal Bill – 3896/H and 867/H should not be supported by existing Municipal Light Departments verbiage has been changed and will hurt us. Both bills have to do with cities and towns that want to form their own municipal light plants.

"No Parking" signs to be installed in front of Hull Light Building. Many complaints about access to door and drop box.

Past employee recognition was discussed. Pat said that maybe we could purchase a bench for Snooky and put a plaque on it in her honor. He researched cost and said we could buy one at cost for \$800 - \$900. Phil said he would not support idea. Phil said that the Hull Municipal Light Board should come up with a policy for all past employees and not just one. Phil mentioned several excellent past employees that have no recognition that he knows of. David and Stephanie assigned task.

Dick researched net metering policies from other municipals. Dick handed out four net metering policies from other municipalities. Asked Board to review them all but highly recommended language from South Hadley.

Hull Wind II – Plant Manager Philip Lemnios finally presented the Hull Municipal Light Board with a Memorandum of Understanding for both Wind I and Wind II. These documents will be discussed at next meeting.
