Welcome/Introduction: Lisa welcomed existing and new members with introduction to Hull PTO.

Minutes: Motion to approve June and July Minutes made by Lisa – Unanimously Approved with one change to June's minutes and two changes to July's.

High School, Mimi Leary requested \$250 for Celtics Basketball Game & Financial Literacy rally transportation – Pending. Lisa getting more information for members.

School Council Elections: A discussion of the High School Candidates and Memorial and Jacobs School status was held. Process discussed.

Fund Raising Event(s) 2005-2006:

The Spirit Bracelets have arrived and a selling strategy was discussed. (School Open Houses, Book Fairs and sporting events.)

The Magazine Drive will kick off in October. PTO will profit at 40% of each sale. A Package will be given to Jacobs School students to sell or renew subscriptions. Memorial School has approximately 320 students which Ann Marie will follow-up with school for package distribution.
