Minutes:

Greg Galvin made a motion, seconded by Mike Buckley to approve the minutes from the January 13, 2015 Special Board meeting and the January 29, 2014 Regular Board meeting as presented.

Payments:

Greg Galvin made a motion to approve and sign the Payroll Warrant for February2015, and the Bill Warrant for February 2015, seconded by Mike Buckley. **Unanimously Voted.**

The Board also authorized \$225,000.00 to be liquidated from PRIT in order to fund the January Payroll.

Refunds:

Greg Galvin made a motion to grant Wendy Cope-Allen, former employee of the Hull Police Department a refund of accumulated deductions. Refund in the amount of \$54,429.29, payable as follows: \$43,543.43 to Wendy Cope-Allen and \$10,885.86, to IRS for Federal Tax withholding as requested by Ms. Cope-Allen. Seconded by Mike Buckley

Retirement:

The board received a written request from Pamela Colley, a new retiree as of November 4, 2014 regarding her first retirement check. Ms. Colley has asked the board to pay her a full retirement check for the month of November as she applied for retirement based upon her next scheduled work day, November 4. Lauren Durham notified the Board that through e-mail conversations with Ms. Colley, she was notified that her first pension

Greg Galvin made a motion, seconded by Mike Buckley to deny the request from Ms. Colley to be paid for the period of time she was not on the retiree payroll from November 1, 2014 through November 3, 2014.

Phil Lemnios requests the amount with held from Ms. Colleys' first check be reported to the town for reimbursement to Ms. Colley as the town had request her to modify her retirement date. Proper notification will be sent to Ms. Colley as well as the town.

John King made a motion, seconded by Mike Buckley to approve a 3% on 12,000 base Cost of Living Increase effective July 1, 2015. The cost is \$3,522.09 monthly and \$41, 905.08 annually.
