The meeting was convened at 9:00 a.m. by Dr. John Silva.

Rhoda Kanet made a **motion** to send five high school students and their principal out of state to a leadership conference. The motion was seconded by Chris Shipps for discussion purposes. Dr. Goyette spoke of the skills the students would be exposed to by this event including fund raising to help pay for the event. School Committee voted unanimously to approve the motion.

Dr. Reynolds brought up the fact that the Town Manager had just informed her this morning that the boat house across from the high school is being declared surplus property by the United States Coast Guard and that the School Department was given the opportunity of writing and submitting a federal grant by July 11, 2003, as to how the School Department would use the facility. A subcommittee of the School Committee was formed to fill out the federal grant form and submit it in a timely fashion. Chairing the committee will be Dr. Russell Goyette with John Silva, Rhoda Kanet, Town Manager Chris McCabe, Selectman Tom Burns, and unspecified representatives from the Life Saving Museum and South Shore Charter School also being asked to participate. The first meeting will be held at Memorial Middle School on Thursday, July 3, 2003, at 9:00 a.m. in the curriculum planning room on the third floor.

Dr. Reynolds suggested that the subcommittee's work could be posted on the town WEB page so that all could collaborate in the process.

Chris Shipps made a motion to adjourn which was seconded by Rhoda Kanet. The School Committee voted unanimously to adjourn at 9:55 a.m.
