Kristen Evans explained that Jonathan Ford, High School Principal did exactly what the policy stated. Mr. Ford had received a list of students failing a core subject from Joseph Sullivan, High School Guidance Counselor. According to the program of studies, biology is considered a core subject.

School Committee members discussed the interpretation of the wording of this policy and stated that the intent of this policy was to raise student standards. A request for this policy be placed on the next meeting agenda and to include principals and guidance counselors be in attendance. Also, information on how many other students were affected in this same manner was requested.
