7.1 Approval of Food Service contract

Dr. Tyrell said the awarding of this bid would be at a future meeting.

David Twombly, Director of Operations discussed the following:

- Bid process requesting proposals for the management and operations of the Hull Public Schools food service program
- Chartwells Dining Service was the winning bidder
- Continued partnership with Chartwells Dining Service
- Capital investment of \$25,000 over the next five years
- \$15,000 will be utilized for kitchen and food presentation equipment
- \$10,000 for the installation of a new marketing program
- \$5,000 in scholarship grants to the graduating senior class
- Guarantee a break-even return up to the first \$5,000
- Estimated profit of \$1,320 for fiscal year 2010

Christopher Callahan, Chartwell District Manager, and Michael Berkey, Food Service Manager presented the following information:

- Where we are in March 2009
- Profit
- Revenues
- Expenses
- Daily sales
- Product costs
- Meal count
- Meal participation

School Committee discussed:

- Student identification cards at all schools
- Student electronically paying for lunches
- Parents being able to pre-pay electronically

School Committee requested Mr. Twombly to look into high school students using electronic lunch cards. Also the cost of parents being able to add money and track balances of lunch cards electronically.
