Mr. Michael Devine, Hull High School Principal, requested the following change to the high school student handbook and district policy JH - Student Absences and Excuses: Credit for courses is awarded on a semester (half-year) basis. Any student who has six (6) total unexcused absences during a semester will be denied half of the stated credits for that course, unless the student earns back those days through their participation in a credit recovery program.
