

The bus for pilot music program will allow eighth grade students to participate in high school music class. The students will arrive at the high school at 7:25 a.m. and spend

thirty (30) minutes of first period with the grade 8-12 band. They will then board the bus at 7:55 a.m. back to the middle school. The Hull Marching Pirates committed to support \$2,000 of the cost of the transportation. Ms. Lanner asked about the crowded bus situation and if this would be an issue if more students were added. Dr. Tyrell explained that the children will be spread over five (5) buses and crowding could occur depending on the size of the musical instruments. This will be monitored closely during the trial period. Bob Belyea from the bus company is also aware of this.

An elementary teacher has been added. The school now has four (4) first grade, four (4) second grade, four (4) third grade, four (4) fourth grade and three (3) fifth grade classes. Mr. Jeffrey Benson, music teacher resigned. This will be a loss to the Hull music department.

4.2 Dr. Tyrell told the committee that there was an item that was not anticipated or known to the Chair.

Laura Miceli, Director of Curriculum, Instruction and Professional Development, resigned. Dr. Tyrell will post the position Tuesday, June 26, 2012. Dr. Tyrell is hopeful the position will be filled from within which will leave a vacancy elsewhere in the district that will need to be filled.
