



## 6.0 Superintendent's Business Items

### 6.1 School Opening

Dr. Tyrell said that the school opening was a success and that the custodians did a great job getting the buildings particularly clean. She added that although it was very warm the first few days it was a smooth opening and the teachers and students were very upbeat and excited to start the new year.

### 6.2 District Goals

Dr. Tyrell gave a brief overview of the district goals that were voted on by School Committee at the August 17, 2015 retreat. She informed the Committee that the three principals will come before the Committee in October to discuss the particulars of the district goals including key action steps and indicators of success. The goals include:

- Continue to work collaboratively with the Hull Teachers Association in order to improve student outcomes across all grade levels.
- Continue to support the effectiveness of all services provided to students that access the Team Based Learning (TBL), Satellite or Teaching Independence and Decision Making through Educational Support (TIDES) programs.
- Identify best practices and resources needed to effectively support students with significant social and emotional needs.
- Educators will increase the use of technology in their instruction as appropriate.
