The meeting of the Hull Board of Selectmen was called to order at 7:34 -pm on Tuesday evening, November 13, 2007 at the Hull Municipal Building, 253 Atlantic Avenue, Hull, Massachusetts

Present: John Silva, Chairman;; Ronald Davy, Vice Chairman; Christopher Olivieri, Clerk; John Reilly, and Joan Meschino, Members. Also present were: Philip Lemnios, Town Manager, and James Lampke, Town Counsel.

Continued Public Hearing – Nantasket Legasea, LLC, Jay Hanflig, Manager, 120 Nantasket Avenue –re: Application for All Alcoholic as a restaurant, Common Victualer and Entertainment License-New.

The Chairman, John Silva, recused as an abutter, as he had done for the previous hearings, handing the gavel to the Vice Chairman Ron Davy. Davy swore in witnesses not Opreviously sworn. (5 newly sworn. No one spoke in opposition.)

Present were Jay Hanflig, his wife Donna, his Attorney Greg Sullivan, and some of his proposed staff.

Town Counsel offered a prepared chart to cover all of the licenses requested for the Performing Arts complex. Lampke said that there are six venues and three separate licenses: Common Victualer; All Alcoholic Beverage; and Entertainments Licenses for the six venues, as shown on the chart.

Licensing to permit the use of the balcony for patrons waiting for restaurant tablea was denied, on a motion to deny by Reilly, seconded by Olivieri, with three in favor and one opposed (Davy)
