

Hull Board of Selectmen

Minutes

May 20, 2008

The meeting of the Hull Board of Selectmen was called to order at 7:30 pm on Tuesday evening, May 20, 2008 at the Hull Municipal Building, 253 Atlantic Avenue, Hull, Massachusetts

Present: Christopher Olivieri, Vice Chairman; John Reilly, Joan Meschino, and two newly elected members, Dennis Blackall and Domenico Sestito, Members. Also present were: Philip Lemnios, Town Manager, and James Lampke, Town Counsel.

Acting as Chairman, Vice Chairman Christopher Olivieri opened the first meeting following the annual election by welcoming Dennis Blackall and Domenico Sestito, the two new members to the Board. Olivieri praised former Selectmen John Silva and Ron Davy for their service to the Town, and suggested a Letter of Thanks be delivered to each.

Olivieri said that he was opening the nominations for Chairman, Vice Chairman and Clerk.

Moved-Reilly: To elect Joan Meschino, as Chairman; Christopher Olivieri, Vice Chairman; and Domenico Sestito, as Clerk.
Second-Sestito
Vote: Unanimous in favor

Chairman Meschino thanked her colleagues for their support and welcomed the new Members, and recognized Sestito who thanked his campaign workers and supporters and the voters of Hull. He said he will work diligently to do a good job. She then recognized Blackall, who said that he received 54% of the vote and that he expects to be an agent of change.
