

Hull Board of Selectmen  
Minutes  
August 22, 2006

The meeting of the Hull Board of Selectmen was called to order at 7:39 pm on Tuesday evening, August 22, 2006 at the Hull Municipal Building, 253 Atlantic Avenue, Hull, Massachusetts

Present: **John Reilly, Chairman; Christopher Olivieri, Vice Chairman;** Ron Davy, Clerk; John Silva, and **Joan Meschino, Members.** Also present were: Christopher McCabe, Town Manager, and James Lampke, Town Counsel.

**Moment of Silence**

A Moment of Silence was observed on the passing of Robert Leavitt, a long-time music teacher at the Hull Schools

**7:30 pm – Fire Chief Lyons re: NIMS Training**

Fire Chief Frank Lyons presented a document explaining the NIMS training program required under the Homeland Security Presidential Directive. The first training session will be held at the High School on September 19<sup>th</sup> from 6-9pm.

**CORRESPONDENCE**

1 Welcomed the request of George Richard Chamberlin, President of World Chamberlain Genealogical Society, to visit Hull for the purpose of genealogical research as a descendent of Henry Chamberlain. an immigrant who settled in Hull with his family in 1618 whom he wishes to honor by dedicating a statue he will provide.

2 Objected to the issuance of a Keno License to the Ocean Club as requested by its Attorney Greg Sullivan and directed Town Counsel to notify applicant by letter to schedule a public hearing. on a motion by Meschino, seconded by Davy and voted 3 ayes; 1 recusal (Silva)& 1 abstention (Reilly) Motion passed.

3 Accepted with regret the resignation of Michael Blanchard from the Water Resource Committee.

4 Unanimously Authorized the signing of form 413, a Civil Service form, as requested by Police Chief Billings in his memo dated August 1, 2006 on a motion by Davy, seconded by Silva.

The Board reappointed John MacLeod to the Water Resource Committee on a motion by Silva, seconded by Olivieri, vote 4 ayes; one nay (Meschino).

Unanimously approved the request of Barbara Cochrane to hold the Second Annual Newport Neighborhood Block Party on September 2, 3006 from 3 pm to 7om and close access to a portion of Revere Street between Newport Road and Stafford Road subject to police input, on a motion by Olivieri, seconded by Silva.

Unanimously approved Alison Leonard, Barbara Lahage and Christine Abbate for 2 year terms to the Local Cultural Council on a motion by Reilly, seconded by Silva.

Unanimously approved Richard O'Donnell, Dennis Riley, Florence Lathrop, Anne Snyder Jacque Jones, to the Hull Historical Commission on a motion by Silva, seconded by Davy.

Unanimously approved the reappointment of Don Ritz and Lori Newmyer to the Hull Historical Commission on a motion by Meschino, seconded by Davy (3-year term).

Unanimously approved Nancy Bilodeau, Nancy Martens, Peter Larsen, Darren Shaw, to the Beach Management Committee on a motion by Silva, seconded by Davy.

Unanimously approved the reappointment of Paul Epstein, Rhoda Kanet and Rod Gilman to the Beach Management Committee on a motion by Silva, seconded by Olivieri.

Unanimously appointed Connie Haggerty, Lawrence Kellem, Anne Musmeci and Jerry McLaughlin to the Beautification Committee on a motion by Silva, seconded by Davy.

The Board recessed at 9:30 pm and returned to open session at 9:45 pm.

**OTHER BUSINESS**

Silva told the Town Manager that the sink-hole from the gas pipe on the street in front of Hole in the Wall has returned, He also requested clarification of Town ownership on Beach Avenue; a list of Town-owned property available and a list of committees.

Unanimously approved pushing for the removal of the fence at the A Street property, on a motion by Meschino, seconded by Davy.

Additional issues were: To issue a license for use of the dump by the Jacobs School; to search for selection of a new Town Manager. Reilly announced that the 911 Memorial Service would be held at 7:00 pm at the Bernie King Pavilion.

Moved-Olivieri: To go into executive session to discuss value of real property and strategy on litigation and not to return to open session
