Lemnios gave an update on Hurricane Irene, which was downgraded to a tropical depression when it got here. Thankfully because of the dedication and experience of our employees, Department Heads as well as employees who serve with Department Heads the community came through the event in great shape. He also mentioned the various Town Departments and the preparations that were done before the storm, during and after. He thanked everyone involved. He spoke about improving communication with residents via, cable, Main Telephone Line at Town Hall and Town web site. Reilly asked about the condition of the beaches and water testing. Lemnios said that the storm had actually cleaned the beaches and he will speak with the Board of Health on the water testing. Rhoda Kanet spoke about the last three power outages in Town being caused by the feeder line coming into Hull, and how we can prevent this from happening ex. make needed repairs or install new line. Brannan asked Lemnios what
