Comments: Unanimous

Reports from members:

General conversation from members who did some of the street analysis......John, Moe, Bob, and Dennis did some of the detailed analysis of the available parking spaces, driveways and available spaces.

John P: John did research about Rockport and indicated that they charge \$25 per resident parking sticker, a senior gets it for \$15 and non-resident beach sticker is \$100.00.

John B talked about the notion of any fees from parking tickets and parking sticker fees to go into a road improvement fund......and the need for our committee to draft an article for next town meeting so that citizens know that all money from tickets and stickers are used for road improvement.

Moe: A variety of options to increase the number of parking spaces.....

- 1. DCR spaces near Beachfire Restaurant......all the way to the end of the DCR lots, taking over the grass area.....that will generate 100 spaces.
- 2. Along George Washington Blvd.....more options along the grassy area
- 3. Rockland Circle along the right up until Saporitos......parking on both sides

We then talked about the previous parking study report. What can be utilized right now?

- 1. Number each parking space in the various parking areas with clearly marked spots that are numbered.
- 2. Utilizing meter monitors to ticket automobiles.
- 3. Why are the meters monitored from 9:00am and not 7:00 am
- 4. The rates for all meters in town should be \$.25 per 15 minutes.....either 1 hour or 2 hour meters.
- 5. Only have meters in place from April to November.

The income from parking fees was \$70,000 in fiscal year 2009

Other suggestions from the general public......

- 1. A toll at the entrances to Hull......
- 2. Special fee for out of towners to purchase a pass......

Two Primary Categories of Concern:

Resident Parking is one issue and the other issue is non-residents coming to Hull

Next meeting, October 25.....let's tackle one item from our first meeting......

1. Begin to understand how the sticker program might be executed...everyone will come with a recommendation for parking (outside of DCR lots) in resident neighborhoods. For full time residents, summer residents and visitors to residents.

Add a new High Level topic-----creation of a separate Parking Department to be responsible for parking tickets and stickers, etc.....how to do this would be another focus of our work......
