Comments: Unanimous

Question about ordinances: Do we have any by-laws that make it illegal to park RV/Boats/Trailers on the street? John B will ask Chief Billings for this answer. John B will ask about the RR bed and the permits issued.

Note about stickers: Placement needs to be clearly articulated in regards to placement of the sticker for convertibles and vehicles that have removable roofs. Other vehicles (boats, trailers) must also have stickers.

Moe's input: Free stickers for each area (neighborhood) that allow you to park in your neighborhood as well at any metered space in town. Visitor passes would be available but Moe doesn't have these details fleshed out yet. (over-riding concept is that no Hull resident owns the street in front of their houses)

Bob B's input: Agree with neighborhoods and different stickers, but we need to improve signs.

Dennis Z's input: Free stickers for all residents and everyone must have a sticker if they wish to park on the street. They are permitted to park in a neighborhood section.

Amy's input: Stickers have a fee, and everyone pays for a sticker. We don't want to burden the homeowners with extra parking from visitors. Every resident should be required to have a vehicle.....how to accommodate renters.....

Jackson's input: Description of how Brookline is doing it to deal with the Fenway Park, and meters. The meters can be adjusted to change the hourly rate.....

Bob D's input: It should be restricted or un-restricted, but not by neighborhoods. And everyone should have to pay for any visitor/guest passes.

Getting to a Summary of the categories we are dealing with:

- Resident vehicle (owner or renter)-Restricted and Un-restricted parking passes
- Daily Guest Passes
- Seasonal pass for visitors
- Retail customers for business areas
- Add dollar amounts for these items if appropriate.
