Warrant Article for Town Meeting:

Given financial situation, it is unlikely that town meeting will authorize any additional bond funding to continue the study at this time.

At the suggestion of Congressman Delahunt's office, the Tri-Town Committee is interested in meeting with several members of the WRC. It was suggested that the Tri Town Committee and the head of the South Shore Chamber of Commerce be invited to attend the public meeting presenting the study results on April 28th.

Committee members discussed alternative sources of funding to continue study.

Presentation of Study Results at the Public Meeting on April 28th.

The public meeting to present the study results will be Saturday, April 28th from 9AM to 12PM at the Senior Center. Flyers for the event will be posted at the Earth Day Festival on April 21st at the MJM Bath House. The Chair will give the introduction and a brief history. J. Musich will give the main presentation and then lead an informal discussion taking questions from the public. Committee members gave feed back on the poster. J. Musich went through the slides for the presentation on April 28th. Committee members gave feed back on the slides. Any additional thoughts and comments should be sent later to the Chair.
