This Committee is charged with reviewing the current USDA revolving loan program and making recommendations to the ED regarding potential alternative uses for the fund.

Sam opened the discussion with a question of expanding the program with supplemental grant funds to conduct a market study or feasibility analysis of certain properties in order to attract potential investors.

As far as the revolving loan fund – the question was raised what new activities could be covered by the program? Could we use it as grants?

Businesses should be polled to determine what their needs are, tie in with the Chamber's poll of its membership.

Melanie noted that downtown interest from the property owners' perspective may be more focused on generating rental income from the storefronts. Business she has worked with indicate the need for marketing support and having a greater on-line presence. That is, blending the bricks and mortar with an on-line retail presence.

Small business is inherently risky. Perhaps the funding could support one on one training. Jo Anne and TEAM Jaffrey have tried small group workshops but with varying schedules of the small business owners, attendance has been weak.

Bill asked for market information that might have been generated for the Dollar General store. Jo Anne noted that the traffic project has a Socio-Economic Analysis included in the needs assessment.

- Research recent market assessments
