#### 3) Town Manager's Report

<u>Building Inspector</u> – Six candidates were interviewed today for the positon of Building Inspector/Code Enforcement Officer. We will be bringing back two candidates for a second interview.

<u>Town Offices Design</u> – Asked the Select Board to grant authorization to negotiate a contract with CMK Architects. During this initial study period, staff has identified nine potential options for locating/construction a Town Office; it is expected that the list of viable options shall be reduced to three in fairly short order. The architect recognizes the strong preference to hold the first public meeting prior to the end of June.

<u>Bond Sale</u> – A Resolution and Loan Agreement should be adopted by the Select Board to allow for the conversion of the Bond Anticipation Note to permanent financing.

<u>Workers Compensation Refund</u> – The State of New Hampshire is now requiring public pools to grant refunds or premium holidays instead of the past practice of crediting the Town's invoice. The Town has been notified by PRIMEX of a refund check in the amount of \$27,090 which will be delived in July. The check will go to the General Fund.

<u>Deputy Town Clerk</u> – As of May  $13^{\text{th}}$  the Town has received twelve resumes for the position; resumes close on May  $22^{\text{nd}}$ .
