APPOINTMENTS

Senator Sanborn came before the Board to give them an update on State Aid Grant Funding for Wastewater Projects which Jaffrey could see \$200,000 in the calendar year 2014 if it is approved by the House and Governor Hassan

Frank Mieso presented the Carolyn and Gordon Merrill Scholarship Trust which entails a scholarship to a Jaffrey student graduating from Conant High School. This scholarship will start with the Class of 2014.

On a motion by Batchelder, seconded by Rothermel, the Board excepted the Carolyn and Merrill Scholarship Fund, approved (3-0).

Angela Beechum came before the Board to discuss her concerns regarding parking restrictions on Stratton Road. Chief Oswalt they will do a traffic and speed survey on Stratton Road and get back to the Board and Ms. Beechum with the results. Town Manager Caron will be checking into the parking situation at Rite Aid regarding extra parking spaces.

3) Town Manager's Report

<u>Building Inspector</u> – Six candidates were interviewed and Caron had follow-up inerviews with two finalists. A Conditional offer of employment was made on May 22; Rob Deschenes accepted the full time positon as of June 1st.

<u>Town Offices Design</u> –Staff develped a list of identifying twelve options to review; as it is imporant for the Board to stay engaged with this project, it is suggested that the Board appoint a liaison who can work with saff on this project. The Board appointed Kathy Batchelder. Next step is to conduct a white board exerceise at which all twelve options will be revilewed and ranked.

<u>Deputy Town Clerk</u> –The Town has received twelve resumes for the position which are being reviewed by the Town Clerk and other elected officals. Interviews are scheduled for June 6th and June 7th.

c) TEAM Jaffrey - Riverfest

TEAM Jaffrey, in partnership with civic organizations, churches and downtown merchants, is holding our award winning event "Riverfest: A Community event" this year on Saturday, July 27, 2013. Events planned Musical Chairs on Main Street, craft fair, children's art and games, library book sale, as well as entertainment, food and fun. Many other community organizations will be setting up and inviting event goers to learn about their mission. This event serves to connect Jaffrey residents, local businesses, and visitors while strengthening and celebrating our community.

We ask the Board to consider the following:

- 1) Permission to use the bandstand and common the day and evening of the event
- 2) Permission to block off the Blake Street Parking lot to vehicles the day of the event.
- 3) Permission to erect a temporary sign on the common to advertise the event (with fee waived)
- 4) That a vendor's license be granted to TEAM Jaffrey for the day with fee waived
- 5) Permission to block the entrance to the town parking lot (at Main Street) the same day of the event. (With bank approval)
- 6) Permission to set up a craft fair on the library lawn the day of the event. (With Joan Knight's approval)
- 7) Permission to close Memorial Drive (directly in front of the Police Station) from 7 am Saturday until 9 pm Saturday to facilitate the event. (With Chief Oswalt's approval)
- 8) Permission to close Main Street between Rt 202 and School Street from 8 am to 4 pm (with DOT approval)

On a motion by Batchelder, seconded by Rothermel, TEAM Jaffrey's Riverfest requests were approved (3-0).

d) Jaffrey Parks & Recreation request road closing at Lake Contoocook Beach effective Monday, June 10th and anticipate the road will be reopened Tuesday, September 3rd.
