MEETING MINUTES APPROVAL

PUBLIC HEARING

Proposed Revisions Stone Arch Bridge Tax Increment Financing Plan

Chairman MacIsaac called the Public Hearing to order at 7:00 p.m. Chairman MacIsaac read the Public Hearing Notice, which was advertised in the *Ledger-Transcript* and posted at the Town Office and the Jaffrey Public Library.

Jo Anne Carr, Director of Planning and Economic Development stated that the objective of this Tax Increment Finance (TIF) District is to help meet the infrastructure needs of the Industrial park, including payment of the bond for bridge construction and bringing Town water to the District.

The Jaffrey Economic Development Council has approved the following projects for inclusion in this revised plan:

- Bridge Bond
- Administration
- Economic Development/Marketing
- Water Main Extension

Bond payments for the Bridge bond will total \$47,187

Total Revenue for the projects is \$204,711 with anticipated returned revenues of \$64,147.

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Downtown Tax Increment Financing Plan

Jo Anne Carr stated that the objective of this Tax Increment Finance (TIF) District is to establish and maintain a Main Street Program for the Town of Jaffrey.

The Jaffrey Economic Development Council has approved the following projects for inclusion in this revised plan:

Total Revenue for the projects is \$335,725 with anticipated returned revenues of \$141,275.
