1. Approved minutes from Nov. 29
2. Budget report: If all items sold at sale price we will have close to \$8000.00 left in account. Some items from final event and time capsule still to be paid.
3. Souvenir report: There are many items left. Right now there is an overall profit of about \$700.00. Jan will ask Caren if she would like packets of a t-shirt, wooden nickel and bell to add to her Christmas charity for Lee children. We voted to reduce prices on many items, some below cost. Scott will advertise in E-Crier and Annie will let library know the new prices.
4. Flags: Scott has been in contact with High-Flying Flags and got quotes for US Flags and hardware. They stated that their flags are of good quality and will last 2-3 years with repairs available. Purchase of 18 flags with hardware was approved and Scott will look into a pole for Little River Park. There was a discussion of possibly using Vets Memorial flags in the park, supervised possibly by VFW with plaques stating the Vet's name and Service. Extra funds will be used for replacement flags until gone, at which time the VFW will continue replacement.
5. Final event about 40 people attended, went well.
6. The presentation at Mast Way by the Dearborn's Company, went well, although some presenters could not make it. The kids were involved and seemed pleased.
7. Bell ringing Jan. 17, 2017...This will take place at the beginning of the BOS meeting.
8. Time Capsule: The closing is put off until Candace gets her photos back from the printer. She asked for final approval of committee which was granted. She did a great job with the images and the committee voted to reimburse her \$200.00 for two spiral bound collections. One will go into the time capsule. The other will be held by Heritage Commission. Since Fred worked many hours editing and enhancing the photos, it was voted that he should receive a 250th sweatshirt as payment.
