HISTORIC GRANGE HALL DAMAGED IN HURRICANE SANDY

The Jeremiah Smith Grange Hall in Lee suffered major roof and window damage from a fallen tree during Hurricane Sandy. Half of the roof will need to be replaced, and four of the historic windows on one side will need replacement. The community rallied right away to remove the tree and to tarp the roof to prevent further damage.

THE AFTERMATH of HURRICANE SANDY

As of Thursday afternoon, November 1^{st} all roads in Lee are open; PSNH reports all of their Lee customers have had power restored; NHCoop reports 2% (13) of Lee customers remain without power; all Schools in the Oyster River Community School District are open.
