Roads Still Closed in Town of Lee

- Garrity Road (155 side after the cemetery); Powerlines still across the road
- Old Mill Road (Pinkham Rd side near the Preserve); powerlines across the road
- Snell Road (at 64- near high tension lines); powerlines still across the road
- Tuttle Road (at Jericho); powerlines alongside the road
- High Road (gravel section); Open to regular travel; Still some low hanging wires. Caution to large trucks.

Eversource as of 9:26 am

Eversource has sent out crews this morning to take care of Garrity, Old Mill, Snell, and Tuttle Roads. These crews should be dedicated to Lee today and are on track for restoring the vast majority of customers in Lee by tonight.

NHEC Statement as of 9:00 am

At the start of the 4th day of power restoration following the wind and rain storm of October 30th, the number of Lee Co-op members without power is 100. Lee's estimated restoration time is this afternoon Thursday, 11/2.

While line crews make progress on hundreds of smaller outages, much of the restoration effort continues off-road today. A fleet of tracked vehicles is spread across Co-op service territory, giving crews improved access to power lines and poles that have been destroyed in locations that are inaccessible by bucket truck. Estimates are subject to change, based on the conditions line crews encounter in the field. Please note that broken piles, inaccessible roads and flooding can affect restoration efforts.
