

Road Update in Town of Lee

- Garrity Road (155 side after the cemetery); **NOW OPEN**; low hanging wires at #22
- Old Mill Road (Pinkham Rd side near the Preserve); STILL CLOSED; powerlines still down
- Snell Road (at 64- near high tension lines); NOW OPEN
- Tuttle Road (at Jericho); NOW OPEN
- High Road (gravel section); Open to regular travel; still some low hanging wires. Caution to large trucks.

Eversource

We are still on track for restoring the vast majority of customers in <u>LEE</u> tonight. Customers without power in communities where neighbors have power are asked to report their outage online at Eversource.com or call our Customer Service Team at 800-662-7764 to report your outage.

The assisted living home, Kirkwood Corners, on North River Road should have power restored very soon. Crews are finishing up the work there this afternoon.
