Lee Transfer Station History Blurbs

2003 Town report-Solid Waste Committee-

- With the hiring of Peter Hoyt and the acquisition of an extractor, the transfer station now has the licensed personnel and equipment to remove Freon from refrigerators and air conditioning units rather than hiring an outside company. This could potentially save the Town as much as \$1,800 per year.
- Resident Survey –The SWC included a questionnaire in a recent Town Crier to solicit input from residents about utilization of the transfer facility. More than 10% of the questionnaires were returned with a variety of comments. Initial response to the survey was to extend hours on Tuesday and Thursday (9am-6pm) while keeping Saturday hours (9amto 5pm) the same.
