

In an effort to navigate the process of forming the new Sustainability Committee, I offer the following draft plan and schedule:

- March 18: Announce openings for Sustainability Committee and invite applications;
- March 25: Continue application period and invite applicants;
- March 28: Select Board discussion of proposed plan and schedule for forming committee;
- April 4: Submit Select Board agenda request for 4/11 meeting;
- April 7: Close application period;
- · April 8: Transmit applications to Select Board for initial review;
- April 11: Select Board discussion of applications(first review), selection process/parameters and guidance on goals and charge;
- April 18: Submit Select Board agenda request for 4/25 meeting;
- April 25: Select Board second review of applications, committee selection/appointments and further discussion of guidance on goals and charge;
- April 25: Appoint Select Board representative to committee.

As I indicated earlier, I am willing to serve as liaison to the Select Board, as we work through this process.

Sincerely, Paul Gasowski 1. Determine and document specific requirements for various departments:

The Facilities Committee will need to complete and update the specific requirements for various departments and end-users(the public, commissions, committees, etc.) for each of the buildings. Where possible, the requirements should be indexed to previous studies and reports, particularly the 2010 TCC Report.

2. Develop a minimum of three (3) options/solutions for addressing the collective needs of each of the Town's departments, the aggregate commissions/committees and the users/visitors of the buildings under consideration:

The 'needs' are to be defined to include: work-related, health and safety, accessibility, social, historical and aesthetic. Options/ Solutions are to be 'framed' as short-term(1-5 years), mid-term (6-10 years) and long-term (11+ years).

3. Complete high level estimates, indexed to relative costs (low to high) and to potential environmental impacts, for the options indicated in #2 (above), to determine feasibility of the work to be completed:

Utilizing the services of established professionals in the field(s), the Facilities Committee should 'frame' the estimates to include resuse, renovation/restoration and new construction. In a comprehensive plan for any expansion or new construction, the current site and other sites within the 1/2 mile radius of the Town Center should be considered.

4. Prepare and deliver a report on the Committee's work to the Select Board, weighing the costs vs. benefits of each of the options that are brought forward.

My thoughts on the charge for the Facilities Committee are:

Scope: consistent with the final TCC document

Deliverables:

- 1. as stated in letter Determine and document specific requirements of the departments. Departments must be listed as well as the frequency of the requirement as at least one department was noted as only requiring space once per month.
- 2. as stated in letter Fully develop 3 options that addresses and meets the needs of each department. As part of the development, the phased approach must be articulated with time frame noted for each phase.
- 3. The options presented must tie back to the goals of the TCC showing whether or not, the goal is being fulfilled. If the Facilities Committee option does not fulfill the goals, there must be clear language as to why the solution is being proposed.
- 4. The estimates must include the full solution addressing the stated requirements. The estimates must include the phasing of the solution and the trade offs of completing the project as one or as multiple phases.
- 5. The estimates must consider the possibility of the church land and include the ~ amount in the final high level estimate, as applicable to the selected option(s).
- 6. Each deliverable must leave no ambiguity such that the committee does not need to debate what is included and what is not included.
- 7. Pros and cons of each option must be fully documented as to how it meets the requirement and satisfies the TCC goals and objectives.

Good Morning:

The Select Board is requesting your assistance with drafting a charge for a new Facilities Committee, to follow up on the work done by your committee in 2015. Please see the attached letter for more information and do not hesitate to contact me if you have any questions.

Ideas for New Facilities Committee Charge

Committee stage 1: (no more that 3-4 months with most work done outside of meetings by teams assigned to each building/office) (this stage somewhat replicates and builds directly on the most recent committee findings but goes further to address many issues ignored)

- 1. Review all previous committee data, and compile building space, capacity, repair and renovation needs (general rather than specific at this time, but including prioritizing of need)
- 2. speak to representatives from each office and commission and compile immediate and five year space needs for daily work function, personnel, storage, meeting, communication (interactions with other offices, commissions, and public) (prioritize needs)
- 3. survey (informally) all possible land available for new or additions to buildings. Include size, EPA restrictions, geological concerns, access issues, parking availability, access to services issues. Create a rough map of these.
- 4. Based on all of this data create three possible scenarios (could be the three already identified) which will be presented to BOS and then the public, with detailed explanations for each plan, requesting input.
- 5. Hire a professional inspector to inspect each building in order to create a list of immediate needs in order to salvage the building for any use.
- 5. Create a list of necessary immediate repairs and restorations that while not addressing possible future use, will maintain the buildings so we don't lose them. Request that the town begin these ASAP.

Committee stage 2: (duration dependent on Architect timeline)

- 1. architect draws up three designs with timeline and budget requirements, according to above findings and public input. (these must include interior but not necessarily outside design details)
- 2. prioritize plans according to needs of buildings and personnel
- 3. present plans to BOS and public in time for public vote in 2017, choosing one option and requesting input on outward appearances and acceptable annual money expenditure for complete project and annual building phases

Committee stage 3: (3 months)

1. With the assistance of the architect finalize one plan with exterior/interior design, budget, etc. of all buildings involved, including well defined phases for completion. This must address all buildings involved, new and old, whether being updated, renovated, added to, or left alone;

and must include all departments, commissions, and community needs as defined in phase 1.

2. present to BOS and public for final vote.

Phase 4 (town oversite...no longer a committee): construction/reconstruction/reuse will take place within the next five years according to the finalized plan. Each year/phase will include only those projects which could be accommodated within the approved budget amount. (exception would be a new building for example which might take two or more years and thus

is given a higher budget allowance.

Dear Selectboard,

Please find two *Discharge of Mortgage* documents to be signed by the Select Board. Below please find an outline explaining the history of these mortgages.

- In 1981 the Planning Board required a Mortgage Deed to be obtained by Walter Cheney to be held as a bond for gravel pit reclamation. See Exhibit A
- In 1986 the Planning Board required a new Mortgage Deed to be obtained in the name of Southeast Gravel as the ownership changed on the existing gravel pit. This should have triggered the release of the Mortgage Deed in Walter Cheney's name but it didn't. See Exhibit B
- In 1993 the Planning Board accepted a cash bond in the form of a passbook savings account, with the Town and Walter Cheney as co-owners of the reclamation bond. This account was set up and the required amount of \$24,000 was deposited. For security reasons, I did not include a copy of the account. My research did not find any discussion at this time regarding the previous Mortgage Deeds. See Exhibit C
- In 2005 the Planning Board hired Civil Consultants to review the entire gravel pit operation to
 determine if the amount held in escrow was sufficient. Upon review and discussion the Board
 required the amount be increased to \$100,000 and additional funds were deposited into the
 savings account. For security reasons, I did not include a copy of the account. See Exhibit D
- In March of 2016 while preparing the Land Sales Full Disclosure Act 50 Lot Exemption Application for Attorney General Approval for his client, Attorney Chris Wyskiel found that the 1981 and 1986 Mortgage Deeds were still on the property and is now requesting that they be discharged. As you can see from the above information, the deeds have been replaced by the savings account and have not been required for some time. Attorney Wyskiel drafted the Discharge of Mortgage documents for your signature. See Exhibit E



with delineation of the 75 foot setback from the bog area and revision of the notes to include reference to the boundary survey done by Robert Moynihan which was used to approximate property lines in the northeastern corner of the pit.

There was much discussion regarding the amount of excavated land that was not yet revegetated. Mr. Blanchard clarified that 7.8 acres were currently being excavated. Board members carefully reviewed the notes on the plan detailing the amount of topsoil stored on site for reclamation purposes, the timeframe for reclamation of various areas in the pit and the amount of acreage identified as reclaimed or scheduled for reclamation. Mr. Beliveau asked for clarification regarding the 16 acres in the northern most area of the pit abutting the Jennison Farms property and scheduled for reclamation in the fall of 1995. Mr. Blanchard explained that these 16 acres were not yet excavated but that he anticipated excavating this area around 1995.

Mr. Barney stated that this had not been a typical growing year as there had been very little rain. He asked whether the Town required that any land identified for reclamation be revegetated as many times as is necessary to ensure the successful growth of plant coverage. It was generally agreed by Board members that excavators must take measures to maintain vegetation of areas identified on plans as reclaimed land.

In response to general agreement of the Board, Chairman LaCourse polled for opinion on a bond for 12 acres, with the understanding that in the event of poor growing conditions, any land identified as reclaimed land on the excavation/reclamation plan be re-seeded until vegetative cover is established. Mr. McLean moved that Southeast Gravel Corporation provide a reclamation bond for twelve (12) acres, in the amount of twenty-four thousand dollars (\$24,000.00), and that the reclamation plans be accepted. Mr. Barney seconded the motion. Chairman LaCourse polled for discussion, there being none, Chairman LaCourse polled for a vote, and the motion passed unanimously. Chairman LaCourse gave Mr. Blanchard his two year excavation permit. The meeting adjourned at 8:45 p.m.



This is a formal notification that after April 1, 2015, 22 acres of "unmanaged white pine" enrolled in the current use program on lot 30-02 were converted to "farm land". Attached is a computation of the land area.


