Glover – have to let them, discussion on Stratham Hill Park fees Gasowski – will the slab be elevated, posts in concrete? Plan for slab later, Reviewed 'state' plan and original plan Kustra - metal roof, low maintenance, already have lumber from trees cut in Town forest LaCourse - handicap accessible? Kindberg – paths already in, could put in handicap parking LaCourse – what is the time table for completion? Gasowski – will volunteer labor be used? Hannon – Yes Kindberg – paths already in, need something for seniors, expand the walking path, continue it from back of ballfield to front of park (pavilion) Stevens – 750' new, estimated \$4000 for equipment and materials, use Highway Dept. labor Kindberg – relatively inexpensive

3. Slide Structure

Kindberg – have all the materials, Tobin Farwell plan, but not designed to accommodate anything but 4' and have 5', 6' and 7' lengths. Need volunteers.

4. Parking

Kindberg – extend parking on either side of entrance, move gate, add parallel parking along road. Worried about kids running around if parking is put at back of park.

Hannon – move the large rocks toward park to make more room in the existing parking lot

Humm – have to make sure any new parking doesn't extend into easement.

Tappan - concerned that moving cars into park 'urbanizes' it

Hannon – parking plan in phases?
