

SEPTEMBER 8, 2014 SAC MINUTES

Meeting was called to order at 9:00 am.

(3) Shirley will contact Denise, town secretary, to see that the notice gets posted at the Safety Complex at least one week before the Medicare Presentation. Shirley will check with Harvey Epstein, program presenter, to make sure he is advised on the projector situation in the downstairs room. Penny will talk with Carolyn, head pharmacist at Walgreens, to ask for the double dose flu shot. (4) The time for first Saturday Nature Walks is 9:30 to give families with children time to “get going.” (5) The Mission Statement will only be published monthly in the E-Crier, not every week.
