**Lee Fair:** Since it is coming right up (less than 2 weeks) there was much discussion about the fair. Cynthia and Charlie McLean have agreed to run the pickle/pie/relish/sweet breads contest this year. Paul Gasowski and Chuck Cox will be supervising the 2<sup>nd</sup> annual Farm Games. The times have been slightly changed from the schedule. They discussed all the games with sleds, wheelbarrows, hay, etc.

For the pig roast, tickets will be \$5 for 14 and under. Paul has made the tickets and posters which went to the library, Town Hall and Farmers Market.

Preparation for the pig Roast: Food prep at the Grange will be Thursday morning when the potato salad and cole slaw, etc. will be prepared. Everything is considerably more expensive this year. Erick has ordered 140 chicken leg quarters, at  $1 - 1\frac{1}{2}$  pounds each. Scouts will set up chairs on Friday, after the tent and tables are up.
