

## Lee Agricultural Commission

June 28, 2016

**Minutes:** They were approved, Dwight motioned to accept them and Chuck seconded.

**Lee 250th update:**

**Parade update:** The Town has been granted the opportunity for the loaned wheels. Erick and others are going to get the wheels on July 12<sup>th</sup>, if the weather holds up. They will do a test run on July 15<sup>th</sup> and then store the wheels in the transportation garage. The timing is not known at this point but there will be a stop by the Town Hall with an emcee giving background on each float.

**Settler's Jubilee:** Brian was at the meeting with an update. The Farmers' Market probably won't happen at the Jubilee. Brian sees static tables around the tent for vendors. Vendors could set up tables Tuesday, Wednesday or anytime on Thursday. Brian said that his Executive Chef would be reaching out to farms for items sooner than later, especially for proteins. They will also mention to each farm that they have the opportunity to display items at the dinner. At this point, Brian doesn't need any help from the Commission but will keep the group posted.

**Time Capsule:** Cary gave an update to what he has so far and what the timeline looks like. The goal is to have everything by the middle of October.

**Lee Farms and Agriculture brochure update:** Paul said that he wouldn't be able to have it done by the end of the month. He has been taking pictures from Facebook pages in order to create the montage. The new goal is to have it done by the Jubilee. There is nothing that Paul needs from the rest of the Commission at this time.

**Lee Master Plan update, presentation July 14:** Erick gave an update but didn't have too much new information since the last meeting. He did say that he has requested a draft before the July 14<sup>th</sup> meeting in order to provide the committee with feedback.
