We walked through the cemetery and evaluated the following;

Sarong

~~Sarong~~: remove two rose bushes.

Eldridge: remove tree.

Yu: remove Scottish Broom Bush already infringing on abutting lot.

Pratt-Larson: cut rose bushes.

Haney –McFarlane: remove dying bush.

Savavong: remove Rose bush.

Wallengford: remove Bittersweet vine..very invasive.

Fogg/ Harvey Frye 1876, stone broken.

Fernald..first row the stone is not attached to the base and in danger of falling over.

Placed several flags and picked up rubbish and plastic flowers.

DURGIN

Placed two flags some stones need to be repaired and leveled. Stones also need to be cleaned.

Remove saplings and prune mature trees. Orion Tree Service,

Pine fence use old pine and paint Van Aiken

FLAGG HILL

Placed seven flags, many stones are tilting and one large slate stone is broken.

Repair the latch on the gate. (Van Aiken)

Scrape and paint the pipe.

LANG

Scrape and paint the fence pipe, several stones are leaning and there is a large base for a stone on the outside of the fence. Needs to be weedwacked.

Placed flags.

PLUMMER

This cemetery is in very good condition. There is one large stone leaning that must be taken care of soon

There is an orphan stone laying on the ground to be researched.

CHESLEY

Placed one flag.

The fence needs to be repaired, storm damage, scrape and paint.

REBECCA BENNETT

Repair pipe fence and one broken stone.

Placed flags.

FERNALD

Paint the fence. No evidence of cleanup or mowing.

CARRIE GRACE

Placed four flags, the cemetery is in very good condition.

CHARLES JONES

One stone in need of repair.

RANDALL

Placed flags. Two rails need repair, must be mowed around the outside or the bushes will begin to grow back.

HOIT

No evidence of cleanup or mowing.

Placed flags.
