**Thibeault Place:** The Thibeault place on Route 152 is for sale and has been offered to the Lamprey River people. Laurel is interested for office space, classes, and river access. She would like us to visit the house when LRAC makes a visit. Preston brought up various problems that might arise such as handicap access, zoning, etc. We discussed the pros and cons.

**250<sup>th</sup> celebration:** The selectmen will be discussing this Monday night. We talked about the reprinting of the 1976 cookbook – should the recipes be changed to be more “healthy” or should we leave it as it is and simply have a reprint. We also talked about events during 2016. How much would a reenactment cost? We will ask Denis as there is someone in town who is involved in reenactments with whom Denis has worked. Laura will go to the Heritage files to learn the date of the actual establishment of Lee as a town, in order to bring this information to the Selectmen.
