**Monitoring of Historical Easements:** After meeting at 9 A.M. at the Town Hall on Tuesday, June 9, visits will be made to Flag Hill, B-D house, and Randall Farm and will be summarized at Sonny's during luncheon.

**Town Center Committee:** S. Bugbee stated that comments by P. Jenkins has stimulated the Select Board to revisit the matter of the TCC at their next meeting.

Lee's 250<sup>th</sup> Celebration: P. Jenkins reported that proposed mast tree event will be discussed on site by D. Quigley after meeting at 3 pm on May 22<sup>nd</sup> in the Church parking lot. There followed a discussion of the possible republishing of John Duncan's "Along the Mast Road" without a decision being made. The Senior Advisory Committee has voted to donate \$1,009.95 to the Heritage Commission to support the celebration. The Commission voted unanimously to accept the donation. D. Hambucken will contact the Payson family to discuss possibilities for historical reenactments during the year.
