**Minutes:** Minutes were read, but not voted on as there was not a quorum at this time in the meeting.

**Seven-to-Save:** We discussed the Seven to Save program and the fact that the Lee Church Congregational Parish House was selected as one of the seven for this years' program. Laurel spoke with Jim Garvin (former director of the N.H. Historic Division) who recommends that we apply for grants for the Parish House. Denis will be sending a letter out to a group of people who might be interested in serving on a Parish House Committee.

**Lee Heritage Signs:** Scott spoke with AMI Graphics about the cost for a decorative sign designating buildings on the N.H. Historic Register. They were quite a bit cheaper than previous estimates from Infinite Imaging. Scott will see about getting a sample from AMI Graphics for the Town Hall. We made a motion, which was seconded, to get a sample, in Soldier Blue, for \$45.

**Randy Stevens' retirement banner** will soon be coming down. Town employees and the Heritage Commission and other interested townspeople will be signing it and it will be presented to Randy at an appropriate time.

**Tote Bags:** We discussed purchasing some tote bags. We talked about flat bags, bags with ears, heavy duty bags, flat bottom bags, etc. etc. Laura will communicate with Laurie Weisz, who does our printing, as to cost and sizes. We thought about putting the Heritage Comm. logo on the bags.

**Railroad Talk:** Randy Stevens will be presenting his railroad talk at the next Historical Society/Lee Library sponsored program. We would like to have this talk taped and we made a motion to spend no more than \$200 towards a video tape of Randy's talk. This motion was approved.
