

## Lee Heritage Commission

November 15, 2018

**Present:** Scott Bugbee, Liz McCaffrey, Cord Blomquist, Denis Hambucken and Laura Gund.

**Minutes:** the minutes of October 18, 2018 were read. Scott made a motion to accept the minutes as written, Liz seconded and the motion was accepted.

**2019 calendars:** 37 calendars have been sold to date. There are six 250<sup>th</sup> mugs remaining.

**Plaques:** The AMI graphics building sign was selected at \$40 each. A motion was made to pay for two more signs and receive permission from the Board of Selectmen to install them on the “Tool Shed with Tramp Room” and the Historical Society Museum. Passed unanimously. Scott will order the signs.

**Seven-to-Save:** Pat (who was unable to attend our meeting this evening), Scott and Laura all attended the Seven-to-Save program where the Lee Parish House was presented as one of the “7 to Save” in 2019. The program was good, Pat presented the information about the Parish House. We enjoyed a tour around the Town of Washington.

**Randy Stevens’ Railroad Presentation:** Randy gave an update of his railroad book to a good number of people at the Historical Society/Lee Library October meeting. The Heritage Commission will pay for the recording of the presentation and copies will be available.

**Parish House Committee:** Denis will invite the folks who responded to his original e-mail to attend an informational meeting about the future of the Parish House. This would hopefully be the beginning of an on-going Parish House Committee. Scott made a motion that the Parish House Committee be made a sub-committee of the Heritage Commission. Liz seconded and all were in favor. Motion passed.

**TCVC (Town Center Vision Committee):** The TCVC will made a presentation at the Board of Selectmens’ meeting on December 10<sup>th</sup>. There will be more information available about progress being made on the Town Center after that meeting.

**Flag Hill:** After a meeting with a team of architects working with Brian Ferguson on his 10 year plan, we discussed the long term plans as they affect the Heritage Easement.
