Treasurer's Report

The revolving fund account has \$14,996.11. There will be about \$9,000 coming out in the spring to pay for the electrical service at Little River Park. The balance will go toward sponsoring the Fishing Derby and the Easter Egg Hunt.

Little River Park Developments

Pavilion Plans

Robin Wunderlich (architect in Lee) presented his plans (prepared pro bono) for the proposed pavilion at Little River Park for the committee to review and comment on. The design is for an open concept with a free standing fireplace. Beams will be bolted, copula on top, barn look. Half the lumber will be donated and the other half will be at a fair price. The concrete slab (\$5,000) and the roof (\$20,000) will be the more expensive aspects. Bat boxes will be a must! Mike Sievert will review (pro bono) the plans to be sure the loading specs are correct.

Ice Skating Rink

Dennis Gelsomini presented plans to build an ice skating rink at Little River Park to be used this coming winter. Wood to build 36 inch high walls on two sides will be purchased from Ricky Stevens. Side boards will be one inch. The fire department has offered to flood the rink to get the surface prepared. Initially, only ¼ inch of water gets sprayed to frozen ground until a base is built up. After that, up to one inch can be flooded. The Recreation Commission will plan to host a bonfire, hot chocolate and skating party in late January.

Dawn made a motion to approve the plan and have Dennis come back with his bills for reimbursement for the hardware at a cost not to exceed \$200. Geoff seconded the motion and it passed.

Harvest Supper Follow Up

Erick Sawtelle said that the supper sold 223 tickets. The meal was delicious and many more tickets could have been sold but they wanted to be sure that everyone who purchased a ticket was fed. The Recreation Commission purchased 23 tickets to thank the sponsors of the baseball field banners. The Recreation Commission owes the Agriculture Commission for these tickets (\$230).
