Little River Park

All equipment requires inspection on a regular basis to be sure that all equipment meets safety standards.

The basketball courts have been getting a lot of use. Larry suggested we purchase padding to wrap the basketball polls with. He will research prices.

Town Field

Broken old soccer goals have been leaning against the tennis court fence and need removed, especially prior to the fail.

The dugouts need cleaned once in a while as occasionally trash is left behind.

Lee Fair 2013

The Recreation Commission will have a booth at the fair to share information, what is going on, what the plans are, etc.

The Fair Committee has asked for help with games during the fair. The Recreation Commission will offer to handle the registrations for games at our booth.

MOU with Lee Conservation Commission.

The draft presented by Bill Humm to Larry and Dawn in July was discussed. When the Conservation Commission comes back with a final MOU, the Recreation Commission will agreed to it.

Lee Recreation Commission Master Plan

The plan which has been in draft form for a year needs to be worked on more and opened up to the public for comment. It was suggested that we host a public forum in September to get input on the vision for recreation in town and how to best serve our residents.
