 - ✓ Peter Vermilyea will oversee all educational outreach.
 - ✓ Gerry Perusse and Cleve Fuessenich will be in charge of coordinating contacts with all the groups involved in Litchfield's businesses and local economic growth.
 - ✓ Gerry Perusse and Cleve Fuessenich will contact all local veterans' organizations to discuss their participation. They will propose the idea of honoring all Litchfield veterans from colonial times to the present for the 2019 Memorial Day Parade with Commander Mark Yanaway.
 - ✓ Lynne Brickley will speak to the Litchfield Garden Club and the Litchfield Aid to the Junior Republic.
- Other groupings to be discussed later include: development and fund raising, foundations, corporate sponsorships, individual funding, marketing, press and public relations, all environmental and conservation groups, athletic groups, cultural organizations, religious groups and civic groups.
- An effort will be made to find out about special highway signs for Litchfield attractions. Cleve Fuessenich and Cathy Fields will look into this.
- Lynne Brickley and Lisa Losee will work to set one regular meeting of the Committee per month through the end of the calendar year and notify members by email.
