- c. <u>Advisor/Advisee</u> program must be in place in 2014 in order for L.H.S. to be accredited, grades 7-11 are included in the program, becomes part of student portfolios.
- d. <u>Special Education: Identification and Exit Criteria, Test Participation</u> reviewed recent changes, documentation requirements have greatly increased, reviewed, Exit Criteria and Connecticut State Department of Education testing requirements.
- e. <u>Grading Practices: Information from LHS Faculty</u> each department at L.H.S. responded, departments follow different formats, work submission and participation need to be further examined, need to decide what a grade represents this work will continue at L.H.S.
- f. <u>LHS Course of Studies 2013-2014 Preliminary Discussion</u> ECE Courses & Hiring; Virtual/Distance Learning, Collaboration with Region 6; looking to see if Engineering course can be offered, no major changes in current curriculum at this

time, will examine changes for Technology courses, discussed rigor of Anatomy and Physiology course and implications for grade weight.
