Jim Simoncelli Jr. stated that a tenant from Wells Run had a clogged toilet due to a wash cloth that had been flushed. American Rooter was dispatched to unclog the toilet. The tenant will be responsible for the cost to unclog the toilet as this was not considered routine maintenance.
