5. **Pregno (West Shore Seafood)** – **442 Bantam Lake Rd.** – Site Plan Modification for Retail, grocery, small format.

Susan Pregno provided an overview to the Commission. The septic is not scaled for indoor plumbing. Letter on file from Torrington Area Health. The Commission spoke about parking and handicap access. No new lights. You will have to go to design review for the sign and lighting. If Ms. Pregno chooses to expand the parking, this will require a site plan and a public hearing. This is adjacent to a house and will require a special exception to show: pavement and lighting.
