1. Chairman, Dr. Susan Lowenthal, called the meeting to order (7:05)

- c. Land Use Administrator, Dr. Dennis Tobin, was present,

- e. Appointment of Acting Secretary; Mr. White was appointed
- f. Approval of Minutes of February 19, 2013: Motion to approve by Mr. Barrows, second by Mr. Pavlick, affirmative vote unanimous with the following edits:
 - i. 10a: Mr. Post's name to be capitalized, Mr. Bramley changed to Ms. Bramley
 - ii. 5a,iv: changed to read "Dr. Lowenthal closed the public hearing"
 - iii. 5c,viii: insert "from High Bridge Road" after the word "re-entry".

 - v. 8b: change March 14 to March 16.
 - vi. 8a: change the word "commission" to "Land Use Office"

4. Review Assessors Open Space Clarification

- a. The section of the 10-20-80 minutes of the commission relating to fractional lots in open space was read into the record.
- b. It was the sense of the commission that a recommendation from the Conservation Commission would be useful.
- c. It was the sense of the commission that the assessor would return with an update.
- d. It was the sense of the commission that a review of the zoning regulations from the 80's and 90's would be useful.

5. Proposed amendment to the zoning regulations (Article IV, Section 5a and 5b)

a. Mr. Barrows moved and Mr. Pavlick seconded a motion to refer the proposed amendments to the zoning regulations (Article IV, Section 5a and 5b) to the applicable regional planning agencies and surrounding towns, voting in the affirmative: Barrows, Pavlick, Post, Lowenthal, Bramley, Kennedy, voting in the negative: Waterhouse. The motion passed. Dr. Lowenthal set the public hearing for May 6, 2013.

6. Land Use Administrator Report

- a. Some signage has been removed from the DOT right-of-way
- b. Dr. Tobin has submitted the budget to the town.

- c. First Selectman, Paul has "frozen" this budget for the remainder of the fiscal year.

 - **a.** Mr. Waterhouse, Mr. Pavlick, and Mr. Barrows will form a committee, tentatively to be called the "Old Route 8 Committee" to consider a zoning amendment to reorganize the neighborhood's drift toward commercial and industrial use.
