TOWN OF LITCHFIELD ANNUAL TOWN MEETING JANUARY 10, 2017

The Annual Town Meeting of the Town of Litchfield was held on Tuesday, January 10th, 2017 at the Litchfield Firehouse. There were approximately 20 electors in attendance. First Selectman Leo Paul, Jr. called the meeting to order at 7 p.m. Lisa A. Losee, Town Clerk, served as Clerk.

The Return of Posting and Publication is attached to these minutes as Exhibit A.

Motion was made by Paul Parsons and seconded by Jon Torrant that L. Cleveland Fuessenich preside as Moderator. Motion was then made by J. Torrant to close nominations, seconded by Diane Knox. There being no other nominations, a vote was called. All voted in favor by voice and motion carried.

Motion was made by J. Torrant and seconded by P. Parsons to waive the reading of the call. A copy was made available to all those in attendance and is attached as Exhibit B. All voted in favor and the motion carried.

The Moderator read Item I: To approve a ten-year lease agreement with Bantam River Corporate Park for office and parking space for dispatchers and drivers of Town authorized vehicles; as recommended by the Board of Finance.

J. Torrant made motion to approve Item I, seconded by D. Knox. There were no questions. Upon voice vote all were in favor and the motion carried.

The Moderator read Item II: To consider a resolution that the Town of Litchfield accept a conveyance, for no monetary consideration, from Bantam River Corporate Park, Inc., a parcel of land of approximately 2.11 acres, more or less, on North Shore Road, Map 187 Block 68 Lot 4K and from Bantam River North Shore Planned Community a parcel of land of approximately .97 acres, more or less, on North Shore Road, Map 187 Block 68 Lot 4H.

J. Torrant made motion to accept Item II, seconded by D. Knox. L. Paul explained the location of the property as lying east to North Shore Road from the buses down to the neighboring house and the adjourning lot to the west of the buses as far as the building. He commented that it was in the best interest of the town to protect from any issues due to the buses being parked there such as oil leaks. In answer to questions he stated that this conveyance does not affect the tax roll and that there were no plans to sell the land at this time. There being no further discussion, a vote was then taken by voice. All voted unanimously in favor and motion carried.

The Moderator read Item III: To authorize the Board of Selectmen to borrow money temporarily in anticipation of taxes and other municipal revenues, to enable the town to pay

budgeted expenditures as they fall due, provided, however, that any funds for the cost of such borrowing shall also have been duly appropriated.

J. Torrant made motion to approve Item III, seconded by D. Knox. L. Paul explained that this was necessary to allow the Board of Selectman to bond or borrow monies as seen fit to cover budgeted expenses. This is not for any added expenditures, only to pay expenses that were approved at the annual budget meeting in May. Upon voice vote all were in favor and the motion carried.

There being no further business to discuss, motion was made by P. Parsons and seconded by N. Knowlton to adjourn. All voted in favor and the meeting adjourned at 7:11 p.m.
