6:00 PM Supervisor opened the informational meeting: regarding proposed changes to health insurance policy. He introduced David LaVoie and Paul Casciero from Reis Group.

LaVoie commented that the current insurance policy ends in July and there will be a 21% increase. CDPHP has reduced the number of plans they will offer. There are changes expected to be enacted in January. The plan that the Town currently has may not be available next year. They have looked at MVP and other insurance companies and there are no projections as to what will be available in January.

Paul Casciero commented that pediatric dental insurance must be provided as of January.

Elaine Rivera stated that the Town had opted to have the policy begin in July because the budget process begins in August and the budget is adopted in November. This gave the Town Board members a figure to work with as the policy was renewed. The average employee makes between \$35,000 and \$40,000. The deductible would increase \$2,500. She commented that the Town has to negotiate with four unions.

Gene Roosa, President for Town of Lloyd unit #8964 of the CSEA.

Anthony Solfaro, President of NYS Union of Police Associations, Inc. stated that he has attended other meetings to discuss this issue and the impact of the new regulations.

Discussion ensued with the end result that the insurance policy will remain the same for this year and review it again in January.

MOTION made by Paladino, seconded by Guerriero, to adjourn the meeting at 6:48PM. **Four ayes carried.**
