Buildings and Grounds: St. 1 Commissioners Bragg and DiLorenzo

<u>SCBA Air Compressor</u>-Chairman DiLorenzo reported that project has been completed <u>Stove-</u>Chairman DiLorenzo stated that he has obtained two quotes for the stove (meeting room) as follows:

<u>Clarkson</u> \$569 plus \$150 to install includes removal of old stove

Lowe's-\$825 for stove, install and removal of old one.

<u>Tables</u>-Chairman DiLorenzo reported that there are some tables with damaged corners in the community room. These will need to be replaced.

<u>Ceiling Tiles</u>-Chairman DiLorenzo reported that the leaks have been fixed, but ceiling tile replacement is needed. Commissioner Bragg to follow up. It was noted that 10-12 tiles need to be replaced in the radio room as well as some in the bunk room and meeting room.

16. Town Emergency Plan-Erichsen, Chief, HHCo President

Town of Lloyd Councilman reported that it is "on the radar"; nothing to report at this time.

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17. Treasurer Report-Treasurer Passikoff

April 2013 Financial Report distributed to Board and Treasurer Passikoff reported that there is nothing alarming at this time; our major items (insurance, workers compensation insurance) are front loaded that is paid at the beginning of the year. We have approximately \$80,000 to appropriate and we can discuss during the business session of this meeting. Commissioner Erichsen stated we need to make sure we have earmarked funds for roof repair.

<u>2012 Audit</u>- Auditors field work done on May 6, 2013 and they interviewed Chairman DiLorenzo and Commissioner Palladino.

- **18. Inspection Dinner-** September 13, 2013 Friday. Chairman DiLorenzo stated that he and Commissioner Fraino reviewed different venues and the Pirate Canoe Club is less costly than The Would.
- 15. **Public Comment-** Chairman DiLorenzo opened the meeting up to public comment. Mr. Bob Pardy stated he noticed that we have no emails addresses on the web page. Mr. Bob Pardy commented that dashcams are now recommended for school buses and stated the fire district should employ them yet the District remains resistant perhaps due to the problems they could reveal. Commissioner John Fraino stated that is not the case, we have checked with our insurance representative and they are not required and he is not in favor of spending money on equipment not a when our experts state it is not required.. Mr. Bob Pardy explained that ESIP supports dashcams and Bill Tricario, a member of the NFPA committee with 47 years of experience in emergency service supports them.
- 16. LOSAP Funding Update-Chairman DiLorenzo stated that at this time he would like to permit Phil DeAngelo (Focused Wealth Management) to address the Board regarding a review of our LOSAP funding. Mr. DeAngelo informed the Board that year to date it is doing well about 6.5 %. Our benchmark last year was at 5 %. Vanguard funds are good of course the return depends on risk. Bonds were good last year. Low quality Bonds are high risk and they are going down. Cash flow is up 6.5% with a yield of 4% of dividends from the portfolio; if we stay even for the rest of the year we could be 10%. Funding for this year could be high 60's to 70%. Current Policy is 50/50. Commissioner Fraino asked if our policy is too conservative. Mr. DeAngelo stated that the long term bear market is over. With bonds we have taken a low risk. Fee for services is 1.5 to 1 % for less than \$ 1 million. Mr. DeAngelo stated that drawdowns are not detrimental. Commissioner Bragg stated we should revisit increasing the LOSAP. Commissioner Fraino stated he feels we should be more aggressive with our funding. Mr. DeAngelo stated that 60/40 is prudent. Mr. DeAngelo suggested wait till summer to review the funding percentage.

IT Project-Web page is completed. Minutes and agendas are online.

Roof-Commissioner Chris Erichsen stated that we need to appropriate funds for the roof.

Treasurer Passikoff placed funds in the Building Reserve and earmarked them with a memo; will show the memo in the next financial statement.

Roof Repairs-Chairman DiLorenzo noted that the repairs were done.

Records Management-District Clerk reported that shelving is on order, shredding is scheduled for June 4 and final organization and narrative remains to be done.

Presentation of Plaque-Chairman DiLorenzo stated that he would like to present a plaque to Past Chief John Gallagher. This plaque was originally presented to him at the Annual Dinner in April; however it needed to be revised due to an error. Commissioner Bragg thanked Past Chief John Gallagher for his service and dedication to the Highland Fire District. Commissioner Bragg stated that people don't realize how big a job it is to serve as Chief.

Harrisburg Fire EXPO-Chairman DiLorenzo stated that commissioners and chiefs will be attending the EXPO; two Chief cars will be used and breakfast and dinner will need to be covered by the district. **MOTION:** Commissioner John Fraino moved to authorize two chief cars be used and breakfast and dinner be paid for by the District, seconded by Commissioner Bragg.

Commissioner Erichsen stated that we need to budget for the roof and AC unit replacements. The Board decided to table until the next meeting. Treasurer Passikoff stated that we did not encumber funds from last year and we are taking from 2012 funds for the compressor. We also need to paint 31-30.

Flowers for Memorial Day-Commissioner Fraino stated he would go to Sorbello's to get the flowers for tour Ladies Auxiliary to plant in time for Memorial Day, however he will request an invoice.

Chief's Car Detail-Commissioner Bragg stated that in the approved bills for this evening there was a bill for detailing of a chief car. Commissioner Bragg stated that these cars should be kept clean by the officer.
