Chairman Dilorenzo stated that we would deviate from the normal order of business to permit Mr. Jim Jeffries of Northeast Computer Services to update the Board regarding recent computer issues that needed resolution. Mr. Jeffries stated that the files currently held on the depository will now be shifted to a server. This will provide better security. This should be accomplished this week. Email is set up; instruction to follow. Back up is provided; data and programs in storage equal 16.9 gigabytes plus another 1.5 gigabytes have been added. Back up takes place every 15 minutes. In bound data equals 100 megabytes; we use 392,000. The restoration process will be reviewed and meets all requirements as prescribed by the NYS comptroller's Office. Server will be delivered Thursday or Friday. A monthly bill for service will follow. Chairman Dilorenzo thanked the Mr. Jeffries for the update.

Snowplow Proposals

Chairman Dilorenzo stated that we have two proposals for snowplowing as follows:

D &D St 1 every 3" \$225 per plow salt no charge St 2 every 3 " \$150 per plow salt No charge

FWP St 1 per storm \$412 includes shoveling and salt St 2 per storm \$255 includes shoveling and salt Option of \$8600 for the season It was noted that this is the same price as last year.

LOSAP-Chairman Dilorenzo stated he would like to discuss the possibility of increasing the LOSAP benefit. Commissioner Fraino stated that we previously passed a motion to discuss the proposal in 2014 after we receive financial results of 2013. Chairman DiLorenzo stated that it is not our decision, the public should be given the opportunity to decide. Commissioner Fraino stated that he is totally in favor of it; however we have been wringing our hands over spending nickels and pennies as we have some large financial challenges ahead of us relative to SCBA, infrared cameras, and turnout gear replacement as well as the apparatus replacement reserve falling short of our requirements in 2019. Chairman DiLorenzo stated that he spoke with Phil DeAngelo regarding the funding and was told that if everything continues we will be at 75% and possibly 80% funding. There was discussion regarding \$40,000 unexpended budget of 2013 could go into the 2014 budget. Commissioner Fraino stated he feels this is an attempt to ramrod this through. Chairman DiLorenzo stated that this is very important to the membership and this is not an attempt at ramrodding this through. Commissioner Erichsen stated he feels this is important however our funding should be in a better position. Chairman DiLorenzo stated that he waited for a full board to be present because this is such an important issue to discuss, however he will withdraw the motion at this time.

Hydrant Testing-

Commissioner Erichsen discussed the testing of the hydrants. It was noted that color coding would be discussed with the Water Department.

2014 Proposed Budget-It was noted that \$1,015,005 would be raised by real property taxes. The percent of operation budget increases is .78% with a rate per thousand of assessed valuation is \$1.171. The Budget hearing will be October 15, 2013 at 7 PM.

Override Resolution

MOTION: Commissioner Bragg moved to override the limit on the amount of real property taxes that may be levied by the Highland Fire District in 2014 pursuant to General Municipal Law Section 3-c and to allow the Highland Fire District to adopt a budget for 2014 that may require a tax levy in excess of the "tax levy limit" as defined by General Municipal Law Section 3-c.

Second: that the Board is the governing body of the fire district with the authority to adopt a budget for calendar year 2014.

Third: the Board notes that the annual budget for calendar year 2014 may be determined by factors not yet established by other bodies with responsibilities under the new law, to be in excess of permissible limits under said Law.

Fourth: the Board finds that the 2014 annual Budget is necessary and proper to fulfill the Board's obligations to provide fire protection within the Highland Fire District.

Fifth: The Board resolves and determines to exceed and override the requirements set by section 3-c of the General Municipal Law for the 2014 calendar year.

Sixth: That this resolution take effect immediately.

This motion was seconded by Commissioner Palladino. When the Board was polled the result was as follows: 5 Yes 0 No 0 Abstain 0 Absent Motion was declared duly adopted. 2013Sept10-147

Adoption of 2014 Proposed Budget

MOTION: Commissioner Fraino moved to adopt the 2014 Proposed Budget with a total proposed operating budget of \$1,086,155.00 of which \$1,015,005.00 will be raised by real property taxes yielding an increase of .78% in the operation budget and a rate per thousand of assessed valuation of \$1.0171, seconded by Commissioner Erichsen.
